

# **ATTICA FAIR ROYALTY CONTEST**

**TUESDAY, AUGUST 9<sup>TH</sup> @ 6:00 P.M.**

1. Open to 2011 Attica Independent Fair Exhibitors and/or young men and women in the Seneca East School District.
2. Age limits as of January 1, 2011 are as follows:
  - I. King/Queen 16-19 years
  - II. Prince/Princess 13-15 yrs
  - III. Junior Miss 9-12 yrs
  - IV. Little Miss 5-8 yrs
3. Entries may be picked up at Seneca East High School, Seneca East Public Library & Making Waves. Or by calling Nan Schumacher 419-426-7131.
4. All entries must be returned to Nan Schumacher 16094 E Twp Rd 104 Attica, Oh 44807, no later than July 1, 2011.
5. Once a contestant has won a title they are not eligible to compete in that contest again.
6. The places awarded will be as follows:

Queen & 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up  
King  
Princess  
Prince  
Junior Miss  
Little Miss

If there are more than four persons competing in any category, a Runner -Up spot will be added.

7. The following are mandatory rules for the conduct and dress of all Royalty.
  - A. Dress for Royalty during the Fair.
    - A. Formal the night of the contest.
    - B. Dress pants or Dresses in the evening (after 5:00pm)
    - C. Nice jeans, dress pants, dress shorts or dresses during the day.
    - D. **NO T-SHIRTS**
    - E. Sashes and crowns must be worn during the fair unless cleaning pens, washing animals or showing animals or 4-H projects.
    - F. Crown is only to be worn if presented the night of the contest.
    - G. NO sashes or crowns in the show arena or at auction

### **Conduct and participation during the fair.**

- A. All royalty will present themselves in a mannerly fashion. Any questions or concerns should be directed to NAN SCHUMACHER, if needed a Senior Fairboard member will be available also.
- B. Required to help with various fair activities.
- C. Royalty are required to participate in no less than five parades or functions
- D. All royalty will continue to represent the Attica Independent Fair until their replacements are crowned the following year.

### **Dress and Attendance for Parades**

- A. Dress according to type of parade per Nan/Queen.
- B. Matching shirts & dress pants.
- C. Formal & Semi Formal
- D. If you are attending a Parade which requires a float you will need to help with set up and tear down.
- E. If a float is being used all Royalty should ride on the float if possible
- F. You may attend any event regardless to other Royalty participation. However, share your participation with the Queen and Royalty Coordinator so that all other royalty can participate as well if they would like. The Royalty Court is asked to help with decorating the stage/hall for next year's pageant.

### **Visiting or Other Events**

- A. As visiting royalty (on Stage), you must dress semi formal
- B. A small introduction for on-stage will be written and approved

### **Queens Participation**

- A. Inviting Royalty for following year
- B. Emcee next year's Contest
- C. Contacting other royalty as to parades and functions.

8. The Queen shall be eligible to compete in the Ohio State Fair's Queen Contest in the year 2009.
9. A mandatory preliminary interview will be held on July 27, 2011 at 6:00 P.M. at the Attica Fairgrounds Entertainment Building.
10. The final portion of the contest will be held on **TUESDAY**, August 9, 2011 in the Entertainment Building at the Fairgrounds. The Junior Miss and Little Miss portion will begin at 6:00 P.M. with the Queens Contest to follow at approximately 7:00 P.M.
